Safety Moment



Drinking and Driving Facts:

The drinking and driving statistics are as familiar now as they are depressing. According to Mothers Against Drunk Driving® (MADD), the age groups are almost all represented equally, with the highest percentage of drunk drivers being ages 21 to 24 (30%), followed by ages 25 to 34 (29%) and 35 to 44 (24%).

Tips to Prevent Drinking and Driving:

- Choose a non-drinking designated driver if you're consuming alcohol.
- Ask for a ride.
- Protect others by taking their keys if they attempt to drive after consuming alcohol. They may be mad at you, but the alternative is much worse.
- If you are the host. Be sure to offer guests plenty of non-alcoholic beverages like water, juice, and soda. Never pressure guests to drink alcohol.
- Serve plenty of food.
- Arrange alternate transportation. If you are hosting, please pay attention to your guests' alcohol intake and behavior. Call a cab, Uber or set up a ride with a sober driver.
- Never serve alcohol to minors.

Detecting Drunk Drivers:

Law enforcement officials say there are several signs associated with someone driving drunk. Keeping these in mind will help yourself recognize and avoid a potentially dangerous situation:

- Making wide turns
- Weaving, swerving, drifting, or straddling the center line
- Almost striking an object or vehicle
- Driving on the wrong side of the road
- Driving at a very slow speed
- Stopping without cause
- Braking erratically
- Responding slowly to traffic signals
- Turning abruptly or illegally
- Driving after dark with headlights off

Remember to be careful on the road this holiday season. Do not hesitate to pull over and safely report drivers you suspect to be under the influence by calling 9-1-1 to help in preventing a tragedy.
